Frequently Asked Questions

Can I call my loved one?

Residents are not allowed to have cell phones while in the program. Please call the Providence Women's Recovery (PWR) phone numbers, 706-519-0404, Monday through Friday if you need to speak to a resident. We will have her call you back as soon as possible. If you need to reach the resident or staff member after regular business hours, you can call our Providence Women's Recovery phone number, 706-519-0404, follow the prompts to leave a message for the Director, and a member of staff will call you back as soon as possible.

Are cell phones, iPads, Kindles, etc. allowed while in the program?

We have found that having electronic devices with Wi-Fi can be detrimental to their recovery. For this reason, these items are not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, personal radios, tablets, laptops, cell phones, cassette players, DVD players, headphones, cameras, iPods, Kindles, and/or Nooks.

What do I do if I need to make a payment or add money to my loved one's spending or medical account?
